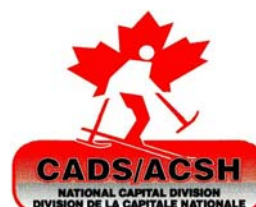

**RULES AND REGULATIONS:** FIS RULES APPLY ( WOMEN'S STANDARD) PLUS LOCAL RULES WILL BE ANNOUNCED AT CAPTAIN'S MEETING. **NOTE:** IT IS A REQUIRED SAFETY PRACTICE AT CALABOGIE PEAKS RESORT THAT ALL ADAPTIVE SIT-SKIS BE EQUIPPED WITH STURDY SAFETY/HOISTING STRAPS TO ALLOW AN INDIVIDUAL TO BE SAFELY REMOVED FROM A SKI LIFT SHOULD A BREAKDOWN OCCUR. THE CADS CALABOGIE PROGRAM COMPLIES AS AN ADAPTIVE SKI SCHOOL OPERATING ON THE RESORT AND ADVISES ALL COMERS WITH THEIR OWN EQUIPMENT OF THIS REQUIREMENT. THE REponsibility LIES WITH THE OWNER TO PROVIDE THE RESORT WITH A SAFE MANNER TO REMOVE THEM IN A LIFT EVACUATION. SHOULD THE OWNER NOT BE ABLE TO ADD THE EQUIPMENT, THEY MUST ENSURE THAT THERE IS A MANNER IN WHICH THEY AND THEIR EQUIPMENT CAN BE HOISTED TOGETHER FROM THE CHAIRLIFT DURING AN EVACUATION.
