ODART Athletes Shine at Stoneham Race

The Ontario Disabled Alpine Racing Team sent 3 athletes to The Quebec Disabled Ski Championships this past weekend at Stoneham Quebec. The Quebec race was unique, in that it was the first time that a provincial disabled championship was run in conjunction with an able bodied race.

The disabled portion of the event was comprised of 2 giant slalom races. Rob Scott of Whitby picked up where he left off after winning the overall title at the Ontario Championships, by posting the fastest raw times in all 4 GS runs. Andy Van Grunsven of Kingston, and James Binsfeld of King City, then swapped results in both of the Friday and Saturday giant slalom races. James captured silver in the first contest while Andy was 4th, then the 2 athletes swapped positions on Saturday, with Van Grunsven bringing home the silver.

Next up for ODART are the Canadian Championships at Kimberly B.C. March 19th to 23rd.
